There is still time to purchase a commemorative brick to be placed in the **Serenity Garden of The Homeless Resource Center!**

On **Monday, January 16th, 2012**, space will be made to show your support!

Each brick purchased will be incorporated into the walkways of the **HRC Serenity Garden.**

For the first time ever, Palm Beach County's Homeless Resource Center will be a single point entry location to connect individuals to services and housing in an effort to end their homelessness. From the time a guest enters the front door, they will receive a diverse offering of quality services and referrals. Guests placed in the Centers' interim housing program will have access to the **HRC Serenity Garden.** The purpose of the garden is to be a natural world environment where the stresses of homelessness can be alleviated.

As a measure of goodwill between the site and the community, affiliated volunteers and 70 student volunteers will be sent out to clean up litter debris around the resource center. Neighborhood beautification will occur concurrently with landscape revival and planting in the garden. **MLK Day of Service** provides an opportunity to complete Phase I of the two phase outdoor space projects for the HRC. Phase II actualizing a vegetable garden will take place at a future date in 2012. Stay tuned!
