Homeless Coalition Joins Forces with Veteran Organizations

On any given night there are 1,421 people in Palm Beach County who are homeless; an estimated 11% of them are veterans. The Homeless Coalition of Palm Beach County has enlisted a number of veteran organizations to join **Project Homeless Connect on Friday, July 15, 2016.**

The Homeless Coalition sponsors Project Homeless Connect several times a year to bring agencies who serve the homeless together under one roof. At next week's event, more than 30 organizations will provide free services such as health screenings, food stamps and housing assistance. In addition, agencies specifically devoted to homeless veterans will provide services like counseling and employment assistance. The Homeless Coalition will offer a free meal, clothing and toiletries.
